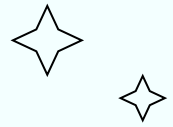

Sensory Friendly Day at the Ballpark

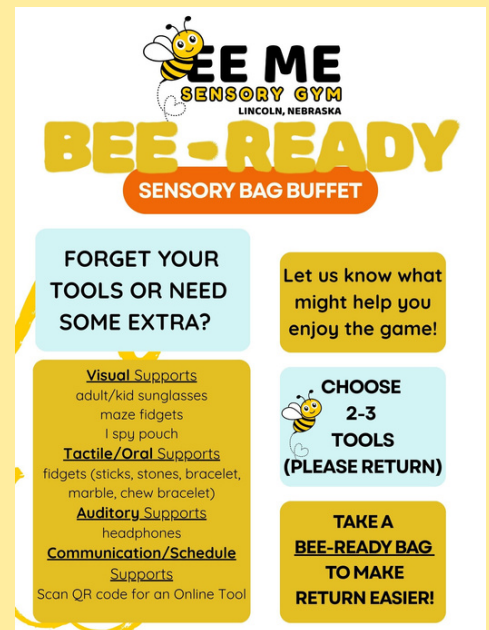
April 19, 2026
